## Our Programs



### Health:

The program supports community-based healthcare programs to ensure that children, mothers, adolescents and youth lead healthy, nourished, and secured lives.



### Education:

The program focuses on ensuring quality education, improving enrollment and reducing school dropout rates among children from age of 3 to 18 years by including age-appropriate learning outcomes and socio-emotional learning skills.



### Livelihood:

Program supports youths in gaining marketable vocational skills and building capacity for self-employment and job creation. Along with providing opportunities for women to empower themselves by linking them to the income generation activities.



### Child Protection:

The program ensures that children live in protective and enabling environment, free from abuse, neglect, exploitation, and violence.
